

## **Information**

An Examination In Public (EIP) on the Cumbria and Lake District Joint Structure Plan has been programmed for 28 September – 8 October 2004. It will take place in the Lake District National Park Authority Offices, Murley Moss, Kendal.

The purpose of the EIP is not to hear objections to the deposit plan or the proposed changes but to have a structured debate on selected matters on which Cumbria County Council and the Lake District National Park Authority wish to be more fully informed. A list of the issues to be discussed and the participants invited to take part in the discussion are attached. Whilst only participants invited to attend can take part in the discussions the EIP is a public meeting and anyone can attend to listen.

The EIP will be conducted by an independent panel appointed by the Planning Inspectorate: Mr Adrian Smith will be the Chair and Mr Simon Gibbs the Planning Inspector.

The Panel will be supported by the Panel Secretary, Mr Frank Hewson and the Programme Officer, Mr Frank Lee. Both are independent of Cumbria County Council and the Lake District National Park Authority and work under the direction of the Panel Chair.
